[Update on Science Adoption \(Mrs. Kerly & Ashley Denman\)](#)

Brief update of Science Adoption process was given regarding selection of four publishing companies evaluated by grade level to determine new science materials. The publishers included: Houghton Mifflin Harcourt, Pearson, Cengage (National Geographic), and McGraw-Hill. Consensus schoolwide ranked the same two publishers highest. Feedback will be sent to district for their review and final selection made. Hank Samuels shared that technology is a large marketing portion of the curriculum materials.

Michelle Curtin, Coordinator of Intervention Services, presented the Local Education Authority (LEA) Profile for St. Johns County School District. St John's County experiences 5-7% growth each year and it is anticipated we will move up into the largest district group. It will change the group of districts we will collaborate with as to handling student growth.

The Kids Closet was successful. Kids Closet raised \$840. Mr. Scott mentioned that the proceeds from the Kids Closet was more effective than what he did in his previous school, which had a donation bin where the school received money by the

pound through an outside organization. He feels our efforts with the Kids Closet is effective because it raises money and benefit our community.

Purchase of instructional iReady upgrade for math was completed. Previously SAC approved to allocate SAC funds to complete this purchase, however after review of internal accounts additional funding was able to be used from SAI. Additionally, the iReady account representative was able to prorate to 6-month subscription, lowering the overall cost to Hartley.

A small surplus of funds for technology was identified by the district. Hartley requested the purchase of additional laptops with these funds. We were able to acquire 35 laptops from these funds.
