School Visits/Volunteers

We are so happy to have volunteers/visitors at Hartley, but please remember the district access procedure for ALL PARENTS and Visitors. In order to access our school past the reception area for any reason, <u>you must be an approved volunteer or vendor</u>. This includes visits during lunch, to attend a field trip, and/or volunteer at school.

To be approved to enter our school, you must complete the volunteer application at the website below:

Once your application has been cleared through the school district and St. Johns County Sherriff's office, it will be valid for three years. Your volunteer status, once cleared, will allow you to sign in at all St. Johns County Schools.
