MAY IS THE MONTH OF ASSESSMENTS

The annual Florida Standards Assessment for our students in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades continue starting May 2 for Reading(Grade 4 & 5 only), Math (Grades 3, 4, & 5) and Science (5th grade only). These assessments are paper/pencil this year. See the calendar on page 4 for all the days of testing.

Hartley students are well prepared to be successful on these assessments. Please help your 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders by making sure they are well rested, well hydrated, and have a good breakfast on the mornings that they are testing. Assure them that they will do well and that they should <u>take their time</u> to "show what they know!"

In addition, all students in grades Kindergarten through Third grades will be taking their final iReady assessments in Reading and Math during the first weeks of May. These assessments allow students, teachers, and parents to see the growth that students have made from the beginning of the year. These tests are taken on computer.

Our school-based extended program will offer care to students from 6:30-8 a.m. before school and from 2:45-6 p.m. after school during the 180-day school calendar year, beginning August 12, 2019 and ending May 27, 2020. (Wednesday Early Dismissal: 1:45-6 p.m.)

As valued members of the school community you know that it is Hartley's goal to provide all students with a high-quality learning experience that develops their social and academic potential. Similarly, the goal of the Hartley extended day program is to offer students a well-supervised, enjoyable enrichment experience in a safe and familiar setting where they feel "at home".

In Hartley's extended day program, students will have daily opportunities for physical exercise, enrichment activities, interactive technology and homework completion. Supervision will be provided by Hartley faculty and staff members.


Working parents require affordable care for their children. Hartley's extended day program offers you an affordable option that is both safe and enjoyable for children and convenient for you.

A copy of your approval letter from SJCSD must be presented at the time of registration. All St. Johns County School District employees are offered discounted fees.
