## Notes from Principal Scott

Dear Families of Hartley,

This week marks the beginning of our fourth and final marking period for the 2017-2018 school year. Marking period three report cards will be available to view this coming Friday, March 23. The link to log in to view your child's card can be accessed on our school's website under helpful links or directly on the SJCS website.

As most of you know, when this week concludes it will lead into a much deserved spring break. When the students and staff return we will be in the homestretch. Additionally, we will begin the testing window for the FSA, our state required testing for grades three to five in reading and math. Students in fifth grade will also take the FSA science. All of our students in K to 5 will also be taking the i-Ready test in reading and math. Our students have worked very hard this year in so many areas and we are confident if they take their time to do their best on these many assessments they will all demonstrate their growth this year. The testing schedule can be found on our school's website and on page four of this month's newsletter. We asked that you work with us to make sure your child is in school on these days and times and that as you schedule appointments they do not conflict with our rigorous schedule. Your support is very much appreciated.

We kindly ask that if you need to call the school that you avoid calling between 8:20-8:40 am and 2:40 – 3:10 pm. These times are during our student arrival and dismissal times; the busiest times of our day. We find that more and more parents are calling during this time. Keep in mind though, that most staff are not available to address the varied needs or requests that often occur during this time. We want to be available to assist and again ask that you be mindful of the time of day you are calling. If there is a change in the way your child is to go home we also ask that you inform us prior to 2:00 each day. As always, we value our partnership with you and are here to work with you for the success of every child.

## Kindergarten Registration for 2018-2019 School Year

The St. Johns County School District (SJCSD) will hold early registration for children entering kindergarten for the 2018-2019 school year.

Tuesday, March 20 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM

Wednesday April 4 1:00 PM- 5:00 PM

Wednesday April 11 1:00 PM- 5:00 PM

To be eligible for public kindergarten in the SJCSD, children must be 5 years old on or before September 1 and must reside in St. Johns County.

**Parents must register children at the school where they are zoned for the 2018-2019 school year.** To find your school, enter your street address on the Attendance Zone Locator at [www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/zoning/](http://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/zoning/). Students zoned for the new K - 8 School “KK” will need to register at Allen D. Nease High School, located at 10550 Ray Rd., Ponte Vedra and students zoned for the new K- 8 School “LL” will need to register at the Aberdeen Community Center, located at 110 Flower of Scotland Ave., St. Johns.

Requirements for registration:

- Birth certificate/Guardianship Documents
- Documentation of a health examination performed on or after August 11, 2017
- Proof of **completed** required immunizations on Form DH680

# SUMMER MARINE SCIENCE PROGRAM

Applications can still be downloaded at any time from the website prior to April 15<sup>th</sup> at <http://www-grms.stjohns.k12.fl.us/> and click on the Marine Science link. The link also will have a complete day by day curriculum for each grade level, parent information, and a video from last year's program.

This summer program is available to all students currently in grades five through seven and has been sponsored by the school district since 1982. Three eight day sessions are held at Gamble Rogers Middle School with bus transportation provided. The dates for the three sessions this summer will be May 29<sup>th</sup> through June 7<sup>th</sup>, June 11<sup>th</sup> through June 21<sup>st</sup>, and June 25<sup>th</sup> through July 6<sup>th</sup>. Small classes of 12-14 students are separated by grade level. All instructors in the program are St. Johns County School District teachers.

The Marine Science Program is a carefully designed experience for responsible students who are interested in learning about our local marine environments. Learning is "hands on" in the field with students kayaking, canoeing, boating, hiking, snorkeling, sailing, windsurfing, surfing, SUP, (stand up paddleboarding), etc. Specific grade level activities and curriculum are attached to the applications and are also available from the website.
