From the Principal's Desk

Hartley to benefit from Controlled Open Enrollment in 2021-22 School Year

Among elementary schools in St. Johns County, Hartley can be considered a small school. A smaller school has the advantage of allowing students and teachers to know one another and develop a sense of family as learning occurs. However, a school can become too small and be in danger of losing funding for teachers and instructional resources. For the past few years, Hartley has gradually lost enrollment, at the rate of 25 students each year. To ensure that Hartley maintains its optimal size, the district has approved limited controlled open enrollment for our school during the 2021-22 School Year. Controlled Open Enrollment allows students to apply for and attend a school outside their regular attendance zone. Pursuant to F.S. 1002.31, St. Johns County will allow a parent living in nearby location, whose child is not subject to a current expulsion or suspension, to apply for an assignment at Hartley next year, up to a limit of 36 students. At this time, 33 families have made application for the available spaces. The application process extends through March 26th.

Teacher Lisa Coe joins Hartley Kindergarten Team

Kindergarten and new students register early!

Voluntary Pre-K: A child must be four years old on or before September 1st.

Kindergarten: A child must be five years old on or before September 1st.

First Grade: A child must be six years old on or before September 1st **AND** satisfy one of the following:

- Satisfactory completion of kindergarten in a Florida public school.
- Satisfactory completion of kindergarten in a non-public school.
- Previous attendance in an out-of-state school in which the student was admitted on the basis of age requirements established by the state of residency.

Registration Requirements:

- Proof of Residency.
- Proof of Immunization.
- Copy of Birth Certificate.
- Physical/Health Exam with in 12 months of enrollment.



Student Health Screening Entry Form

Please assess your child daily for the following symptoms and answer the contact questions.

- Fever of 100.4 or higher
- Uncontrolled cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Muscle aches
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Is your child currently awaiting COVID-19 test results? **If yes, please keep your child home and notify the school nurse when test results received. Further instructions will be discussed at that time.**
- Does your child live in the same household with someone positive for COVID-19? **If yes, your child must quarantine for 10 days from the last date of contact with the positive individual. The quarantine period may be shortened to as few as 7 days if a negative PCR test result is obtained on day 6 or later from exposure to the positive case. The Dept. of Health will assist in clearing your child to return to school once they have received the negative test result.**
