Congratulations to Fifth Grade Students- Rising Middle Schoolers!

In just a few weeks, Hartley's fifth graders will complete their elementary school experience and begin middle school in August at Gamble Rogers and Murray Middle Schools. Some of our boys and girls began at Hartley in kindergarten and some were new to us this school year- we wish all of them the very best in the future. Fifth grade is a milestone year in St. Johns County and we are very sad to say goodbye to our students. Hartley Hawks know that they are always welcome to return to their first school.

New COVID Guidelines

Individuals who have been fully vaccinated – that is, two weeks or more have passed since the second dose in a twodose vaccine or the first dose in a one-dose vaccine series – are not required to quarantine following exposure, provided he/she does not develop new symptoms of COVID-19.

The Department of Health (DOH) requests that we follow the current contact tracing protocol, regardless of vaccination status. They will contact exposed individuals to ensure no symptoms have developed, research his/her vaccination status in the state system, and provide further COVID education. The DOH will determine if the individual is exempt from quarantine. The Health Services Department, as well as the school nurses, will work diligently to assist students, parents and staff in this process.

Student Health Screening Entry Form

Please assess your child daily for the following symptoms and answer the contact questions.

- Fever of 100.4 or higher
- Uncontrolled cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Muscle aches
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Is your child currently awaiting COVID-19 test results? If yes, please keep your child home and notify the school nurse when test results received. Further instructions will be discussed at that time.
- Does your child live in the same household with someone positive for COVID-19? If yes, your child must quarantine for 10 days from the last date of contact with the positive individual. The quarantine period may be shortened to as few as 7 days if a negative PCR test result is obtained on day 6 or later from exposure to the positive case. The Dept. of Health will assist in clearing your child to return to school once they have received the negative test result.
