**Athletic Requirements**

Participation on an athletic team is a privilege that carries significant responsibility. Student-athletes are expected to model maturity, respect, and dedication, setting a high standard for the entire school community. At St. Johns County School District, we emphasize leadership by example both on and off the field. Athletes must adhere to the coach's expectations and conduct themselves in a way that reflects positively on both their school and themselves.

To participate in sports at a St. Johns County School District school, student-athletes must meet the following requirements:

- **Physical Examination:**

A current sports physical, dated no earlier than June 1, must be completed using the FHSAA Physical Form prior to the first scheduled game. It is recommended that students submit a copy rather than the original physical form. Original documents should be retained for use in other sports throughout the school year. To protect student privacy, physical forms are shredded at the conclusion of each season.

- **Academic Eligibility:**

Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0. Any student failing a class is ineligible to participate in games until they achieve a GPA of 2.0 or higher and are passing all classes. It is the student's responsibility to communicate with the sports director to confirm eligibility status.

- **Disciplinary Action:**

In order to participate in extracurricular activities (including athletic programs), students must adhere to School Board rules, school rules and applicable law. It is important for students to understand that the behavioral expectations placed upon them by the school can extend beyond the classroom and school campus. Participation in extracurricular activities is a privilege. The school administration may restrict a student's extracurricular activity privileges in connection with poor attendance, repeated tardiness, and/or disciplinary action administered under Section 4, or when in the judgment and discretion of the administration such restrictions are in the best interest of the student or the school.

- **Attendance:**

On game days, athletes must attend at least half of the school day to be eligible to participate in that day's game.
