- Apples sliced with a tablespoon of lowsodium peanut butter.
- Pears dipped in fat-free/low-fat cottage cheese.
- Vegetables paired with hummus or tzatziki sauce, such as:
  - Carrot and celery sticks.
    - Bell pepper slices.
  - Zucchini or cucumber rounds.
  - Broccoli and cauliflower florets.
    - Cherry or grape tomatoes.
      - Roasted chickpeas.
  - Popcorn (air-popped or made with a nontropical vegetable oil).
  - Rice cakes and whole-grain crackers.
    - · Unsalted nuts and seeds.
