## Healthy Snacks week!

Hartley's first healthy snacks week is October 13th- October 16th! Please help your student to bring a healthy snack each day that week.

From the American Heart Association a few healthy snack ideas for "Munchies that Crunch":

- Apples sliced with a tablespoon of low-sodium peanut butter.
- Pears dipped in fat-free/low-fat cottage cheese.
- Vegetables paired with hummus or tzatziki sauce, such as:
  - Carrot and celery sticks.
  - Bell pepper slices.
  - Zucchini or cucumber rounds.
  - Broccoli and cauliflower florets.
  - Cherry or grape tomatoes.
  - Roasted chickpeas.
- Popcorn (air-popped or made with a nontropical vegetable oil).
- Rice cakes and whole-grain crackers.
  - Unsalted nuts and seeds.

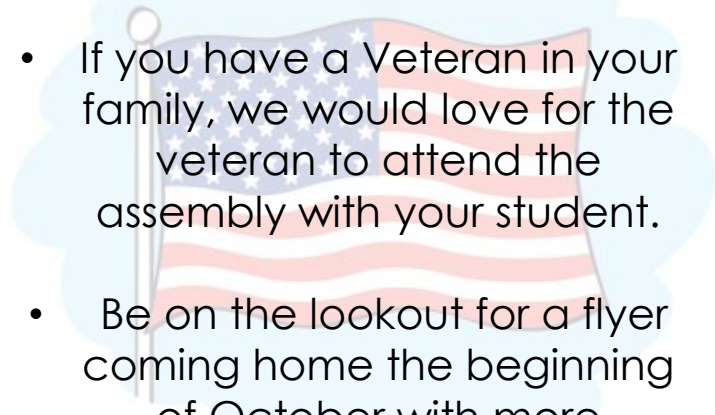
